ELIGIBILITY, CONDITIONS & LIABILITY

- **As part of our effort to respect and empower marginalized communities, we ask that all Stonewall event performances and art pieces using culturally traditional elements either be created/ led by someone from that culture, or that the artists/performers acknowledge the origins of their craft and educate the audience about those origins in some way, in or surrounding the art piece/ performance;**
- **Art must be hang-ready (or place-ready) with all necessary hardware attached when it is dropped off.**
- Include a description of your piece and the elements used along with a photo (if possible) of your artwork with this submission form;
- Each piece submitted should include a clearly written label on the back with name, title, medium, and price (if applicable). Include a brief description to be placed with the artwork;
- Excessive gore, art promoting violence, hate or drug use, or anything deemed pornography is subject to removal or refusal;
- We reserve the right to refuse any work;
- The artist is responsible for delivering and retrieving artwork for the show during designated times, at MONCA. Stonewall will contact you and inform you of these times via email after your application is received. You may contact us at 530.893.3336 or art@stonewallchico.org for questions about drop-off and pick-up;
- Entries must be original, entirely the work of the artist, and not be copied, derivatives, or based on other copyrighted material;
- Artist retains all copyright on work, though Stonewall may use images of the art to promote art show;
- Every reasonable precaution to protect artwork will be taken during set-up, exhibition, and removal. Stonewall is not responsible for damage sustained by art submitted, nor any injury or damage done because of art submitted;
- Artists may sell their work. Stonewall is not acting as an agent, however, every effort will be made to connect potential buyers with the artists to facilitate sales.

Agreement:

Submission of the entries, whether by Internet, standard mail, or hand delivery, shall constitute an agreement on the part of the artist to comply with the conditions set forth in this submission form, including the following;
