Applying for Stonewall Internship Programs

Any student interested in interning with Stonewall should send our Intern Coordinator a resume with three references and a letter of intent detailing why they want to work with Stonewall, what skills and qualities they would bring to an internship, and which internship program(s) they are interested in. Students may choose to apply for more than one program, and will either be matched to the one they fit best or will participate in a combination of programs.
